

AUTO DEMOLITION DERBY

ALLEGANY COUNTY FAIR – SATURDAY, JULY 24, 2010 – 4:00 P.M.

Promoted by the Whitesville Volunteer Fire Department and the Allegany County Fair.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Derby will be comprised of individual heats, one Best of Show Feature, and one Main Feature. Each heat winner will receive \$100. The Best of Show Feature winner will receive \$100 and a trophy. The Main Feature winner will receive \$300 and a trophy. The decision of the judges in all events will be final as to determining the Best of Show and the Winner. There will be NO TIES.
2. The Promoters reserve the right to approve or reject any or all entries.
3. Participants of the Derby may not be employees of the track or the Fair Association.
4. Heat winners may use another Heat car in the Feature if his/her car is unsafe to participate.
5. The Allegany County Agricultural Society or the Whitesville Fire Dept. shall not be responsible for the car(s) or for property stolen from the car(s).
6. Each driver may enter a maximum of two cars and must fill out an entry blank for each.
7. Crew members and drivers will be admitted to the "Pit Area" for a fee of \$18, (\$10 for the pit area and \$8 for admittance to the fair grounds). Each person must also sign a release. NO children will be allowed in the pit.
8. Registration of cars is from 11 a.m. – 3 p.m. Absolutely NO registration or inspection after 3 p.m. ANY DRIVER NOT OBEYING THE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
9. Bring "title" to car you are entering if you want to sell the car.
- 10. ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE RESIDENTS OF ALLEGANY COUNTY WITH A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE ID.**

RULES FOR DRIVERS

1. The driver of the vehicle must be 18 years old or older and hold a valid driver's license. However, 16 & 17 year old drivers with valid driver's license may participate with a Minor's Release signed by a parent or legal guardian. NOTE: The Minor's release must be signed and witnessed by a Demolition Derby Official at the time of registration.
2. All drivers must wear long pants (NO SHORTS) and a shirt. Full body protection is required.
3. All drivers must wear a SEAT BELT and SHOULDER HARNESS, HELMET, EYE PROTECTION. Neck braces and roll over bars are suggested, but not required.
4. NO SMOKING is allowed on the track or in any vehicle on the track at any time.
5. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES allowed in the Pit Area or on the Track at any time. ANYONE FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PREMISES.
6. NO one allowed in the Pit Area under the age of 14 years. NO EXCEPTIONS.
7. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR STATE FAIR, THE WINNER MUST BE FROM ALLEGANY COUNTY.

DEMOLITION DERBY GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS RULES FOR VEHICLES

1. Any automobile 2 door, 4 door, or station wagon will be allowed. NO Trucks, Jeeps, Sport Utility Vehicles, Limos, Ambulances, Hearses, Chrysler Imperials, or other commercial vehicles allowed. No 4 wheel drive vehicles of any sort.
2. Windshield is optional. It can be left in or taken out.
(Note: Canaseraga – must be removed, Rushford – optional)
3. Sun visors, windshield wipers, all lights, glass (except windshield, see item 2 above), mirrors, all chrome, all moldings, door handles, and antennas must be removed.
4. Two (2) 5/16” thick straps or two (2) 5/16” Diameter rods must be secured at the top and bottom of the windshield area to avoid hood from going through windshield and injuring driver.
5. Vehicles must have a full bench seat or two bucket seats in the front of the car.
6. NO more than 5 gallons of gas allowed.
7. NO exterior Gas Tanks (behind the rear wheels) will be allowed. Interior Fuel tank consisting of Boat tank, Fuel cell, or Metal type tank only will be allowed. Interior tank must be installed behind the front seat and secured to the floor with at least 2 straps and covered with a fireproof shield.
If exterior tank cannot be removed, it must be punctured to remove fuel.
Any fuel leak will call for immediate disqualification.
8. Batteries may be left in vehicle in front of the firewall in the engine compartment.
Optional: Battery may be moved to the front passenger area, and must be securely fastened to the floor with at least 2 straps and have a non-metallic cover.
9. All doors, hood, and trunk must be securely fastened with chains or straps. No welding allowed. Hood and trunk must be able to open for inspection. Hood and trunk must be secured with no more than 4 fasteners on each.
10. One pipe no smaller than 2 inches and no larger than 4 inches in diameter reaching from B post to B post is allowed to be securely fastened behind the front seat. Height position must be below the top and above the middle to support the seat. Acceptance of any pipe used will be the decision of the judges. Any pipe that comes loose during the event will result in disqualification of the driver.
11. Two 8” diameter (minimum) holes, one on each side of hood located over the engine compartment is required. NO protruding metal.
12. Cooling system may be left in or taken out. NO antifreeze/coolant allowed. Engine must be flushed. (NO dumping on the ground) Fan blade may be removed or must be removed if not protected by a fan shroud.
13. All vehicles must have operational brakes.
14. Shock absorbers must be in original position and free to move. Vehicles must be at original height with stock suspension. NO special bumpers, reinforcements, or trailer hitches allowed. Energy absorbing bumpers must be free to move. NO welding allowed.
15. All vehicles must have only summer or all season tires on all 4 wheels. NO off road cleated tires or aggressive tire treads allowed (Inspector’s discretion). Tires must be 4 ply rated or less. Wheel weights must be removed. NO alterations to wheel rims or attachments to rims allowed.
16. ONLY the drivers door to be painted YELLOW with no writing on either door. Number will be assigned. Numbers will be put on both doors and on top. A 2 foot x 2 foot area on top to be painted White for your car number. NO obscene writing allowed on car.

Any driver not obeying the rules will be disqualified. The decision of the Track Officials will be final.
